

# Canary

*Gauge:* 16 sts and 22 rows = 4 inches  
In stockinette stitch

*Suggested yarn:* Berroco Vintage Chunky

*Needles:* #9 US (5.5mm) 16 inch round needle.  
Or needles needed to obtain gauge.

This hat fits 19-22 in head circumference. (Age 4-adult small)  
If you increase or decrease size, use multiples of four.

## *Abbreviations:*

K-knit                    st-Stitch                    r-round  
P-purl                    co-cast on  
K2tog- knit two together  
Kfb- Knit into the front and back of one st.  
(This is an increase of one st.)



## *The Pattern:*

Co 68 sts using a knitted co. Join for knitting in the round.

### *Brim and increases:*

r1-14: K2, P2, repeat to end of round  
r15: \*K8, Kfb\* repeat from \*to\* until 7 sts remain.  
K6, Kfb.

### *Hat body:*

r16: K all sts  
r17: K2tog, repeat to end of round  
r18: Kfb of every st  
r19: K all sts

\*Repeat rows 16-19 until hat measures 8.5 inches for child or 10.5 for adults.  
Be sure to end with a row 19.

### *Decreases:*

r1: \*K1, K2tog\* repeat from \*to\* to last st. K1.  
r2: K2tog to last st, K1.  
r3: K all sts  
r4: \*k1, k2tog\* repeat from\*to\* to last st. K1.

## *Finishing:*

Break yarn leaving an 18 inch tail. Thread yarn through sts, starting with the first st on the round and moving clockwise to the last st. Pull yarn through tightly. Weave in all ends.
